SHARED SERVICES

Supervisor Scott Aubertine reviewed the recent proposal by Governor Cuomo initiating a plan for shared services between the County and other municipalities as a means of cutting county costs. He put this item up for discussion. County Legislator, William Johnson addressed the issue, stating he will be attending a meeting in Albany to gain further information on the subject. It was the general consensus of the Board Members that the County would be responsible to draft a plan for any shared services. However, the Boards have agreed to gain further information and report on it at the next meeting.

CHAUMONT COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

Supervisor Scott Aubertine reported that the Board of Directors for the Chaumont Community Foundation approached the Town for additional funds to help offset the cost of production of the Lyme Light brochure for the community. He suggested assistance may be provided as a joint effort by the Town of Lyme, Village of Chaumont, and Lyme Central School in the way of making some of the copies for them at the three locations. Each municipality will research the printing costs associated with this suggestion. The findings will be discussed at the next meeting.

LYME YOUTH COMMITTEE

Supervisor Scott Aubertine inquired about the use of the LCS gymnasium each Sunday by the Lyme Youth Committee. Superintendent Cammy Morrison stated while there were a few minor incidents that recently occurred, they have since been resolved and she continues to welcome the use of our facility by the LYC.
