Algebra I is a course designed to prepare you for the upcoming Common Core Algebra I Regents Exam in June (passing this exam is a requirement for graduation).

Materials needed:

2-inch binder 3 dividers Pencils 3 Ring Pencil Pouch

TI-nspire CX calculator- Every student in Algebra I will be assigned a calculator that he/she is allowed to take home but will be responsible to bring to class each day (as they would a textbook).

Grading:

Homework 30% Tests 40% Quizzes 20% Classwork 10%

Homework:

- Homework will be assigned and checked by the teacher daily. (1 point for attempting the assignment by the next day.)
- A unit's worth of assignments will be turned in as a packet on the day of the test for that unit. One point per assignment will be earned for turning these assignments in completed- no late packets will be accepted. At least one assignment from the packet will be chosen by the teacher to be graded for correctness (5 points each). You will not know which assignment(s) ahead of time.
- You may ask questions in class, after school, etc. to get help on assignments anytime before the packet is due.

Tests:

- Tests are given at the end of each unit.
- Test Corrections for half points back will be allowed on some tests.

Quizzes:

- Quizzes may take place at any time; large quizzes will be announced ahead of time, small quizzes may be unannounced.
- "Throwback Thursday" assignments will be counted as quizzes. These are weekly assignments that must be completed on the website <https://www.deltamath.com/>.

Classwork:

- Bellringers and Exit Tickets need to be completed daily.
- Other classwork assignments need to be completed when assigned.

Other Expectations:

- You are expected to bring your binder, planner, TI-nspire, chromebook, and a writing utensil to class everyday.
- All makeup work, including notes, is the responsibility of the student! You need to ask for any worksheets that you are missing. Tests and quizzes will be made up the day you return to class.
- You are expected to use the videos provided by emathinstruction to make up missing notes and/or supplement your learning when you are confused.
- Bathroom passes will not be given when I am teaching. I will not give passes to go to your locker so bring all of your materials with you when you come.
- USE OF CELL PHONES/ IPODS ETC. WILL NOT BE ALLOWED DURING CLASS.
- Please ask me questions about the course work when you are struggling, I will do my best to answer as many questions as possible.
- Come in for extra help if you need it.
