Nominating petitions may be obtained from the District Office – 11868 Academy Street, Chaumont, NY, Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM- 4:00 PM, and are available as of March 1, 2022. All nominating petitions must be filed with the District Clerk, no later than 4:00 PM on Monday, April 18, 2022. All nominating petitions must contain a minimum of 25 signatures of qualified voters of the Lyme Central School District.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND QUALIFICATIONS:

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD OF EDUCATION:

1. Must be able to read and write
2. Must be a qualified voter of the district
3. Must have been a resident of the district for at least one year prior to election
4. Not more than one family member of the same household shall be a member of the Board
5. Cannot be an employee of the Lyme Central School District

QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTERS:

1. A citizen of the United States of America
2. Eighteen years of age
3. A resident of the District for a period of thirty days in advance, as required by law
4. No person shall have the right to register for, or vote at any school meeting or election who would not be qualified to register for or vote at an election in accordance with the provisions of Section 5-106 of the Election Law
5. Do not need to be a taxpayer to vote or to be a candidate
